1. In a couple of words, how would you describe the home you grew up in? How has that background shaped your own home now?
2. Read Proverbs 1:8-9. How do you teach (convey, communicate) truth in your home? Does it need improvement? What can you do to get better at this?
3. Read Proverbs 3:11-12. How does the way you relate to your children personally teach them about God? What would they conclude about how God deals with His children by the way you deal with yours?
4. Read Proverbs 3:35. Think of the three types of honor Pastor Ken mentioned (toward children, toward parents, toward spouse). Is honor abundant in your home? What's it look like? How can you improve?
5. What happens in your home (or happened as you grew up) when children misbehave? What opportunities does misbehavior present? Why are those important moments?
6. If an unbeliever walked into your home, what would that person learn about God by watching you in action? What can you do to make your home a better object lesson to teach about God?
