2. Facing your toughest task (vs. 11-18)
3. Facing your strongest enemy (vs. 10, 19-20)

FOR FURTHER THOUGHT:

1. Who's the most famous person you've ever met? Were you nervous meeting him/her?
2. Name a major challenge you've had to overcome. What helped you do it?
3. What does it look like to "pray without ceasing" (1 Thessalonians 5:17)? Compare the prayers of Nehemiah 1:4, 1:5-11, and 2:4. How would you characterize each of them? Paul speaks of "all prayer and supplication" (NIV: "all kinds of prayers and requests") in Ephesians 6:18. He speaks of several kinds of prayers in 1 Timothy 2:1. How do those verses help us to pray without ceasing?
4. What is your biggest fear right now? How can your confidence in God help you face it?
5. What is your toughest task right now? How can your confidence in God help you shoulder it?
6. Who is your strongest enemy right now? How can your confidence in God help you deal with him/her/it?
7. What part of your life lies in ruins now and needs to be addressed if your life is to bring glory to God? What can you do about it this week?
