3. In what ways might you be like Jesus' brothers? How can you live more and more according to Jesus' time?
4. How are Jesus' words in verse 7 demonstrated in the remainder of the passage?
5. What is the best way to understand the apparent contradiction in Jesus going up to the feast in verse 10?
6. Why is it important to understand that the message that Jesus taught was under the authority of the Father?
7. What is the connection that Jesus makes between authority and glory in verse 18? How does that connection help expose the danger of self-righteousness and self-seeking glory?
8. How does this passage cause you to trust Jesus more?
