We need to be very discerning about the input we receive!

1.	People "depart from the faith" (v1) when they are led astray (v2)
2.	Deceivers contradict God's Word (v3)
3.	It is possible to wander from God's Word on the side of liberalism or conservatism $(v3)$
4.	Three things will help us discern what is good (v4-5):
	a. God's Word
	b. Prayer
	c. Godly counsel

- 6. Read 1 John 2:18-25 (especially v19). What does someone walking away from the faith say about whether they were ever saved? What other Scriptures inform your position?
